Cheddar Gorge Road 10km 2022

Route for runners and spectators back to Winchester Farm

Congratulations! We hope you enjoyed your run, they your legs are suitably tired, your eyes enjoyed the delights of the route, and your belly is suitably satiated from our post race treats, or perhaps a cider in town....

Please allow 40mins to walk back Winchester Farm, following the directions below for the safest, most traffic free route back.

Warren Farm Runners – If you parked at Warren Farm, you need to catch a bus back to the farm at either 11:15, 11:30, 11:45, 12:00 or 12:15. After that time, we can not help you get back to Warren Farm.

Winchester Farm Runner – If you are parked at Winchester Farm, you have a bit more time on your hands, and we just need all cars to be cleared from the farm by 17:00 at which point the farm closes its gates and you will be locked in!

1) Head down the gorge for 1km

Head through the village, samples some snacks and ice cream as you go, you deserve it!

After about 1km you will be reaching the end of the shops and you need to turn left onto The Lippiatt.



On your right hand side is a Tickets & Information office (the words Ticket and Information has just been painted over, but this stand along building is still recognisable), straight ahead is a bridge over a stream (DO NOT CROSS), make a left turn just before the bridge and turn onto The Lippiatt

2) Bear right onto St Andrews Road

You are really only on The Lippiatt for about 20, before you bear right and move onto the footpath on the right hand side of St Andrews Road.



3) Stay on St Andrews Road for 500m

You will pass a few roads which branch off along the way, keep going straight. You will pass The Croft on your right hand side, then Tor View on your left hand side, followed by Woodview road on your right, before you finally reach a T Junction at the end of St Andrews Road.



Stay on the footpath, turn right onto Redcliffe Street and go straight for 50m

4) Take the footpath over the river



Staying on Redcliffe Street, take the path with the **white railings** over the river.

5) Cross the road to move onto Union Street

Carrying on a straight on direction, cross the road to be outside the now TSB branch (white washed windows) and carry on the footpath past Bouquet Florists.



6) Follow the footpath round to the right onto Bath Street

Union Street becomes Bath street, as the path moves around to the right hand side, passing the monument on your left hand side.



You will then go past the Bath Arms pub on your right hand side.

7) Cross the road just after the Bath Arms Pub

Immediately after the Bath Arms pub is a pelican crossing, cross here, make a right turn and keep walking in the same general direction, away from the village.



8) Pick up the cycle path by the **RED PHONE BOX**, and **RED POST BOX**

50m after the crossing you will pass a Tesco on your left hand side, and from here you will be able to see a **RED POST BOX** and **RED PHONE BOX** directly ahead.



After the post box, immediately red phone box, is a sneaky little footpath behind the public toilet building. Take this path and know the intricate turns are now done! This one is easy to miss!

9) Stay on the cycle path

The cycle path takes you 800m further towards Winchester Farm. You will go past some playing fields on your right hand side, keep going straight on the footpath, the path rises and falls over a stream below.



Carry on straight at the first road crossing, aiming for another red post box directly ahead. Love all these red landmarks!

10) Cross Labourham Way and Labourham Drove

Take care crossing the road here



Take the left hand turn past the big farm barns/industrial units and you are about 400m away from Winchester Farm.



This is the left hand turn immediately before the left hand turn to Petruth Paddocks campsite.

11) Follow the track past the units on your left hand side. Winchester Farm is directly ahead.



Runners who parked in Winchester Farm return to their cars and head on their journey. You need to have left the farm by 17:00 at the latest or you will be locked in!

12) Return buses to Warren Farm

Buses back to Warren Farm will leave at 11:15, 11:30, 11:45, 12:00 and 12:15. We need to get everyone home in these 5 trips. If the first buses are quiet, we may need to delay their departure so that everyone can catch the bus back.
